The tender is due for submission up to 1.00 p.m. on ...24.02.11. & the part-1 will be opened on the same day at 3.30 pm in the presence of attending tenderers.

Tenders should be submitted in sealed cover containing two separate sealed envelopes- Cover -1 for technical bid and the Cover-2 for price bid and both the covers should be put in Cover-III. On the date of opening of tender , only the technical bids will be opened. Price Bid of the technically qualified bidders will be opened on a later date which will be informed to the qualified bidders only.

All the covers must be superscribed with the tender number & date, date of opening and Cover number and are to be put into the tender box provided for the purpose.

1. Earnest Money: An amount of Rs. 50,000.00 (Rupees Fifty thousand only) only shall be deposited by the tenderers along with their quotations in the form of Bank Draft duly drawn in favour of `EASTERN COALFIELDS LIMITED, A/C, JHANJRA PROJECT, payable at SBI, Asansol. Earnest money deposit by unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded immediately after finalization of tender. Earnest money of the successful tenderers will be converted to security money which will be refunded after successful execution of order. Earnest money will be forfeited if any tenderer fails to submit order acceptance within 15 days from the date of order.

2. Security Deposit: The successful tenderers will have to submit Security Deposit within (2) weeks time @ 10% of the value of the awarded contract with out having any ceiling in the form of bank draft, including EMD. S.D will be refunded within 30 days after satisfactory execution of the contract. For unsatisfactory performance and/ contractual failure, the Security Money will be forfeited.

N.B.: If any State/ Central Govt. Organisation / PSU & Valid DGS&D/ NSIC Registered(for tendered items) Firm can produce documentary evidences issued by Govt. Authorities for according exemption towards submission of Earnest Money deposit/ Security Deposit, they may be considered for exemption from submission of Earnest money deposit/ Security Deposit.

3. The rate should be quoted on FOR, Jhanjra Area Store Basis. The quotation should indicate rate per unit. CST/VAT should be clearly mentioned. Discount, Excise Duty, Freight, Packing and Forwarding, Loading and Unloading, Insurance charges if any should be clearly mentioned separately.

4. The L1 bidder (L1 rate) will be decided on the basis of landed cost, which includes basic price of material, CST/ VAT, excise duty, transporting charges, insurance charges and any other element of cost.

5. The price quoted must be firm and valid for acceptance at least for six months from the date of opening of tender.

6. Firm delivery period should be specified.

7. Payment: Within 30 days after receipt and acceptance of materials.

8. Products must be packed in bags. DGMS approval No. with date of expiry, Date of Mfg., Batch No., Date of expiry and Manufacturer`s name must be printed on each and every bag.

Tagging in bag is not allowed.

9. The manufacturer shall furnish all relevant information in respect of chemical composition, properties, mechanical parameters and specification, schedule of checking, checklist, usage and storage manual etc. on every consignment of supplies.

10. Materials will be inspected by us at our site. Product will be accepted after satisfactory performance of the sample of each consignment taken at random. In case the performance is not found satisfactory, the material will not be returned and it will be destroyed at our end with the presence or information to the supplier. The supplier will not have any claim of payment for the said supply.

11. Please furnish Trade License No; VAT/Sales tax Registration No. SSI Registration No. if any. Please also submit the professional tax clearance certificate and PAN No., Banker`s name and address and Bank Account number. You have to submit the status / declaration of your firm as per the MICRO, SMALL & MEDIUM ENTERPRISES DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2006 along with the offer.

12. The cement capsules must have shelf life of 6(six) months.

13. The tenderers must give location and complete address of their works.

14. Risk Purchase:- In the event of failure of the supplier to deliver the store within the stipulated date/ period of supply order or in the event of breach of any of the terms and conditions mentioned in the supply order, Jhanjra Area has the right to purchase the stores from elsewhere after due notice to the defaulting supplier at the risk and cost of the defaulting supplier. The cost as per risk purchase exercise may be recovered from the Bills against any other supplies pending in the Subsidiary Company and also in any other Subsidiary Companies of CIL.

15. Force Majeure Clause:- The successful bidder will advise, in the event of his having to resort to this clause by a registered letter duly certified by the local Chamber Of Commerce or Statutory authorities, the beginning and the end of the causes of the delay, within 15 days of the occurrence and cessation of such Force Majeure Conditions. In the event of delay lasting out of Force Majeure, ECL will reserve the right to cancel the contract.

16. L.D may be imposed in case of late delivery @ ½% per week or part there of limited to maximum of 10% for the undelivered portion.

17. Delivery: 30000 nos. per month (quantity of phases may vary).

18. PRICE FALL CLAUSE: It will be the condition of the contract that all through the currency of the said contract, the price at which the stores will be supplied shall not exceed the lowest price charged by you to any other agency including DGS&D, New Delhi. In the event of price going down, you shall promptly inform such information to enable ECL to amend the contracted rates for subsequent supplies.

19. The tenderer who will download the tender document from website must enclose demand draft towards tender fee along with their offer.

20. The tender may be opened in the next working day in case the same can not be opened on the scheduled date due to some unforeseen circumstances like Bandh/ strike/holiday etc.

21. Tender papers may be supplied free of cost on demand to all Govt. Undertaking / Ancilliary units of ECL /NSIC registered firms for the same item.

22. Corrections where unavoidable shall be made by crossing cut initialing date and rewriting. No over writing should be done which may render the render invalid.

23. Every page of the tender documents should be signed by the tenderers as a token of acceptance and have company`s seal.

IMPORTANT PARAMETER FOR QUALIFYING IN TECHNICAL BID.

1. Manufacturers having experience in supplying the above materials to any Sub Sidiary of CIL/ Govt. Organisation / PSU or to other Mining Industries against regular order should quote along with the copies of such orders received by them in past duly certified by a notary public.
2. The firm must have valid regular DGMS approval for Cement Capsule. A copy of valid DGMS approval letter duly certified by a notary public must be enclosed.
3. The firm must submit the list of apparatus and testing facilities available at their manufacturing unit duly certify by a notary public.
4. The firm must submit 50 nos. of free sample along with the offer. The firm will qualify in technical bid on successful performance of sample in the mines of Jhanjra Project Colliery.
